



## NAFB Foundation Scholarships Procedures

Since 1977, the NAFB Foundation has provided financial support and educational opportunities in the form of college scholarships to assist students in pursuing careers in agricultural communications. More than \$608,000 in scholarships have been awarded.

In 2024, the NAFB Foundation is offering multiple \$7,500 college scholarships and one \$10,000 scholarship. This year's recipients will be honored at the prestigious NAFB Convention in Kansas City this November. As part of the award, each recipient will receive an expense-paid trip to attend the convention, a unique opportunity for networking and learning.

Applicants must be a college junior, senior or graduate student for the fall 2024 semester and enrolled in or transferring to an agricultural communications curriculum. Strong consideration will be given to candidates with concentration and/or application in broadcast media (including internet/online media distribution).

Applicants must provide their current GPA, expected graduation date, sources of financial support, personal statements, an audio statement, as well as their resume, official college transcript, three letters of reference and a photograph.

Each application is carefully reviewed and scored by a panel of judges, which may include the NAFB Foundation President, a past NAFB president, a past scholarship winner, a foundation board member, and a collegiate advisor. Their collective expertise ensures a fair and thorough evaluation process.

The top-scoring applicants are awarded scholarships as determined by individual scholarship requirements.
