Matt Brechwald is a small farmer, agricultural entrepreneur, agricultural podcaster and farm broadcaster. He has been referred to as "the most prolific agricultural podcaster" in the United States and hosts a total of three agricultural podcasts and releases five new episodes per week.

Matt is heavily involved in profiling the work of agricultural entrepreneurs on The Off-Farm Income Podcast where he has released over 650 episodes since 2014. On this show Matt profiles adult business owners one day per week and FFA members with entrepreneurship SAE's (supervised agricultural experiences) twice per week. Matt is a very frequent contributor to the satellite radio show "FFA Today" on Rural Radio, SiriusXM Channel 147.

Matt has not always been an entrepreneur or broadcaster. After receiving his bachelor's degree in animal science from Montana State University in 1996, Matt left agriculture to serve his community as a police officer. He wound up staying in the career for 15 years before returning to agricultural with the purchase of a farm in 2011. Since that time Matt has started and sold an agricultural service business, started the Off-Farm Income Podcast and created a broadcasting business hosting, producing and editing agricultural podcasts for other companies.

Matt lives in Kuna, Idaho on a 25 acre farm with his wife, Autumm, and daughter, Hattie, where they raise beef cattle, pigs and goats which are direct marketed to customers in the Treasure Valley of Idaho.
